**DEFENDANT E.G.’s MOTION TO VOLUNTARY WITHDRAW HER MOTION TO
APPOINT A GUARDIAN AD LITEM**

AND FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE HER ANSWER

NOW COMES Defendant E.G. (“E.G.”), by her attorneys, and respectfully submits this Motion to Voluntary Withdraw her Motion to Appoint a Guardian *Ad Litem* and for Extension of Time to File Answer (“Motion”), and states as follows:

On August 2, 2007, E.G. filed a motion to appoint a Guardian *Ad Litem*. (Doc. #27) The Plaintiffs have since filed a response (Doc. #31), and E.G. filed a Reply (Doc. #33). Subsequent to the Motion being fully briefed, E.G.’s mother, Susan Dukes, has executed a declaration that expressly waives any conflicts of interest that may exist by and through the undersigned counsel representing E.G. at the same time they represent E.G.’s father and brothers. Indeed, the declaration expressly allows the undersigned counsel to represent E.G.’s interests in addition to those of her father and brothers. Based on E.G.’s desire to be represented by the undersigned counsel and the waiver of any conflicts by E.G.’s mother, the undersigned counsel have agreed to represent E.G. Thus, the undersigned counsel no longer see the need for the appointment of a

Guardian *Ad Litem*. For the foregoing reasons, Defendant E.G. respectfully moves this Court to allow her to voluntarily withdraw her Motion to Appoint a Guardian *Ad Litem* with all parties to bear their own costs in relation to the Motion.

Additionally, in light of the foregoing, Defendant E.G. moves for an extension of time to file an Answer to the Amended Complaint such that she be permitted to file her Answer on or before September 17, 2007.

Counsel for E.G. have conferred with counsel for Plaintiffs who have no objection to the relief sought herein.

WHEREFORE, Defendant E.G. respectfully moves this Court to (a) allow Defendant E.G. to withdraw her Motion to Appoint a Guardian *Ad Litem*, (b) withdraw the Motion to Appoint a Guardian *Ad Litem*; and (c) allow Defendant E.G. until September 17, 2007 by which to file an Answer to the Amended Complaint.
