Plaintiffs write in response to Defendant's letter of April 9, 2008 (Doc. No. 229). Enclosed with her letter, Defendant provided the Court with a copy of a letter addressed to SafeNet, Inc. from the Department of State Police for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Defendant does not and could not, however, explain what relevance this letter has to Defendant's motion to compel in *this* matter. (Doc. No. 217.)


