

Dear Magistrate Judge Levy:

I write on behalf non-party SafeNet, Inc, f/k/a MediaSentry, Inc. ("SafeNet") to join the arguments of Plaintiffs put forward in their letter of June 3, 2008, in response to the letter of Ray Beckerman, Esq., dated May 23, 2008 to reconsider the Court's May 16, 2008 Order.

SafeNet would only add that the issues that Defendant seeks to relitigate not only have been subject of multiple rounds of briefing, but were also thoroughly aired at oral argument where the Court permitted all parties to freely assert their views. Consequently, Defendant does not advance a single fact or legal point that the Court overlooked. Disagreement with the Court's ruling on points that it did consider is not an appropriate basis for a motion for reconsideration. *E.g., Basciano v. Lindsay*, 2008 WL 1700442 (E.D.N.Y. 2008)(NGG)(RML).
